Minutes of the PCNS BBQ/Meeting of June 24, 2017

Herb held a drawing for 5 door prizes of various coins and medals.

Members Exhibits: Michael Turrini brought a large binder containing his PCNS collection of medals and exnumia. Don Hill passed out 2017-P mintmarked cents to each attendee, noting that there was no advance announcement that the 2017 cents of Philadelphia would show the mintmark, so he had to scramble a bit to acquire them.
